Parallel Printing Programmes – How to join in.....

What to do if you would like to take part:

- 1. Read the 'small print' below to make sure you are happy with the arrangements.
- 2. Email me at debwing-printartist@outlook.com to say you would like to join a programme, giving the date of the programme you would like to join. (DO NOT pay any money at this stage.)
- 3. I will email back to say if I can reserve a place for you on the programme as there are a maximum number of places.
- 4. When I have reserved your place, please arrange payment and let me know you have paid.
- 5. I will confirm payment and your place on Parallel Printing.

Full cost of taking part - £85 (£80 if you pay by bank transfer – the increased cost is to cover PayPal charges).

If you are unable to afford the full cost and really want to take part - £60

If you are still struggling to afford to join in, please tell me in your email so that I can try to help you to take part.

- 4. It is your responsibility to make sure you have the equipment to take part.
- 5. Zoom sessions are 'live', so it is important you can join in (if you miss one, it won't be a disaster!).
- 6. I will never share your email address with anyone else outside of our group and you can request that I delete your personal contact details at any time.
